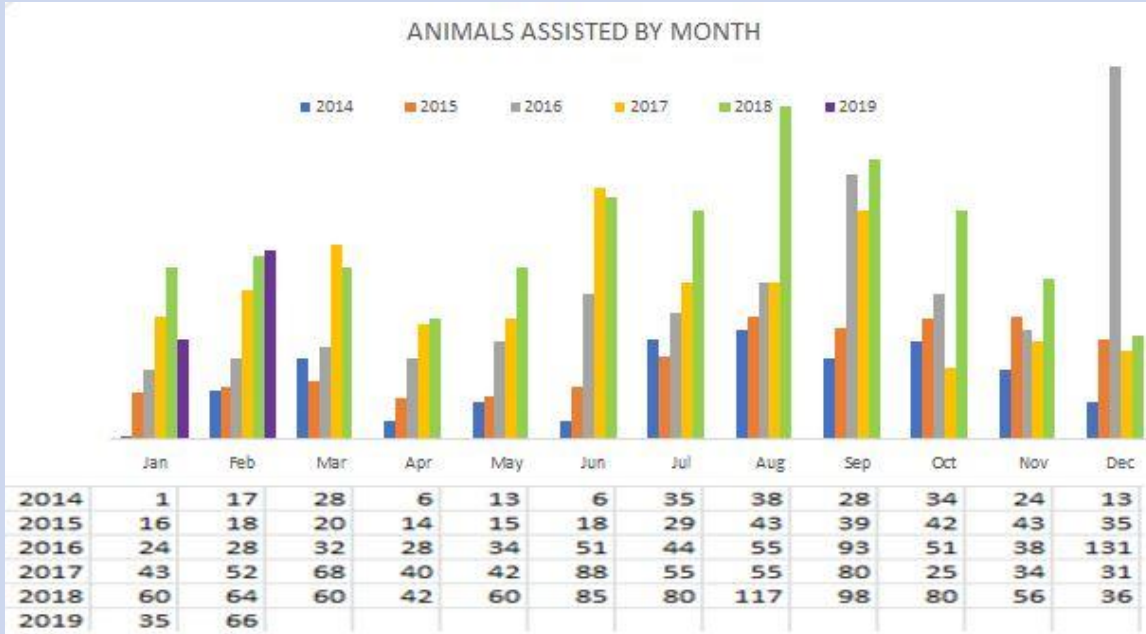
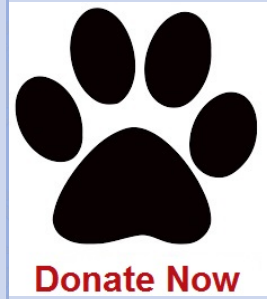




## Spring Newsletter 2019

- 7 years - 370,092
- 8 years - 2,072,514
- 9 years - 11,606,077

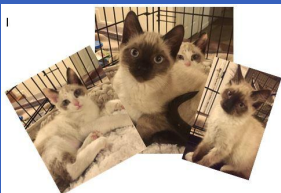
