

Hathi and her husband Jerry Prettyman live in Pleasanton with their three dogs: Hunter (Golden Retriever/Boxer mix), Comet (Weimaraner/Lab mix) and Misty (Bichon Frise/Shih Tzu mix) - all of them are rescues. Outside of Paws in Need, Hathi is president of a private family foundation whose primary mission is to help foster youth transitioning to adulthood.
