

Here are some commands for your new puppy:

- 1. **Sit**. It's the first command a puppy should learn!
- 2. Stay. Move one step away at a time.
- 3. Come. Watch it run to you!
- 4. **Down**. Use a gentle pull to reinforce.
- 5. Go to your place. Every dog needs to learn this.
- 6. Wait. No bolting out of open doors!
- 7. **Nipping**. Correct with gentle scolding, and praise when it stops.
- 8. **Barking**. A Quick pull or tug, and "quiet" gives it the message.
- 9. **Jumping**. Correct with a push to the chest and "Off!"
- 10. **Pulling**. Use a stop-and-sit correction until the dog adjusts to your pace.
